2014 a PRC diplomate told Zhang that Beijing would reimburse him the entire amount he donated to the PET Foundation

A senior official in PRC's global network of state promoters

Member of 12-14th National Committee of the CPPCC,

President of the top national level, state supervised China Cultural Industry Association (CCIA),

Chairman of the state affiliated Millennium Golden Eagle International Media Company

2013 Zhang donated \$800,000 to U of T Faculty of Medicine to commemorate Norman Bethune's legacy in China, a favorite theme of united front's propaganda

University of Toronto (U of T)

2013: Hosted a series of events about Norman Bethune at the Beijing Four Seasons

2014: Erected a Bethune statue on campus

Awarded CCTV's "China Economic Person of the Year"

His family was named "Role Model of China's Strategic Philanthropy"

2016 Zhang & Niu pledged \$200,000 to the PET Foundation, \$750,000 to UdeM law school & \$50,000 to erect a statue of PT (also a Mao statue but rejected by UdeM) at the law school

University of Montreal (UdeM)

PT studied & taught at UdeM's law school



Established diplomatic ties with PRC in 1970
A Mao Zedong fan & praised Great Leap Forward

Pierre Elliott Trudeau (PT)
PM: 1968 - 1979
1980 - 1984 (LPC)

Jean Chretien (JC)
PM: 1993 - 2003 (LPC)
Served in Pierre Trudeau's cabinet

Endowed the PET Foundation with \$125M in 2002

Pierre Elliott Trudeau Foundation (PET Foundation)

2001: Founded

2016: Sacha Trudeau, brother of PMJT, unauthorized but signed the \$200,000 donation agreement with Zhang Bin & Nui Gensheng

Tax receipts related to the donation didn't comply with Income Tax Act

A receipt showed that money was not from the two men but from Millennium Golden Eagle International's Canadian subsidiary, and the Hong Kong address used was invalid

2023: The entire board, including President & CEO, resigned after reported by media

1981 First visited PRC while principle of McGill U
Re-established medical exchange with Peking Union Medical College

2012 Renewed the 2006 partnership he signed with Nanjing U & received honorary doctorate from them

2013 Called Nanjing U his second home & "home away from home"

Visited the PRC a dozen times as GG of Canada

2013 Encouraged Canadian students to spend one of their most important periods in life in the PRC

2017 Met with Xi in Beijing on the same day when Nobel Peace Laureate Liu Xiabo died in custody

3 out of 5 daughters studied in the PRC

Took free trips to China paid by the PRC or pro-Beijing business groups

As former immigration minister & ambassador, worked for Chinese immigration company

Support Meng Wanzhou's release



David Johnston (DJ)

2010 - 2017 Governor General of Canada, appointed by PM Stephen Harper

Close friend of the Trudeau family

Since 2018: A member of the PET Foundation (members appoint the board & deal with bylaws & other matters)

March 2023 Appointed special rapporteur by PMJT to investigate foreign interference, Dwnplayed PRC's election interference & advised against a public inquiry

Rideau Hall Foundation (RHF)

2012: Set up & chaired by DJ

2017: PMJT gave RHF \$10M when Johnston completed his GG term, DJ became full time chair

Paul Desmarais III is Director Emeritus

Dominic Barton (DB)

Appointed Ambassador to China after John McCallum was fired 2019 - 2021

Global Managing Director for McKinsey & Company from 2009 to 2018

Chaired Advisory Council on Economic Growth

Chancellor of University of Waterloo from 2018 to 2024

John McCallum (JM)

2002 - 2019 Served in the cabinets under PMs Chrétien, Martin & J. Trudeau

2015 - 2017 Minister of Immigration

2017 - 2019 Ambassador to China

Former Chief Economist for the Royal Bank of Canada

2017 Took free trips to PRC valued at \$73,300, paid by PRC/pro-Beijing business groups

2019 Fired as ambassador after publicly supporting the release of Meng Wanzhou, the Huawei CFO who was accused of fraud by the US & in the midst of extradition hearings

2019 - 2020 Worked for Waillian, a Chinese immigration company

DB was chancellor for U of W from 2018 - 2024

People's Liberation Army (PLA)
CCP-controlled (not state)

Huawei Technologies

Founder Ren Zhengfei is a former PLA officer

Involved in the PRC's state surveillance programs

Banned by many countries from their 5G networks

Fiasco of Meng Wanzhou & the two Michaels

Extensive & strong research partnership with Huawei during Dominic Barton's tenure as Chancellor

University of Waterloo (U of W)

2006: DJ started a partnership with Nanjing U to set up Sino-Canadian College

2006: Established Confucius Institute (CI)

CI contract said any disagreement in running the CI should be referred to their Beijing headquarters, called HANBAN

2008: Director of CI at U of W rallied students to defend the PRC's crackdown in Tibet & protest against media reports, forcing a TV station to apologize

2023: CI closed

2016 - end of 2023: Huawei had extensive research partnership with U of W

PRC Ministry of Education

Office of Chinese Language Council International (HANBAN)

Under the PRC Ministry of Education

2004 First Confucius Institute (CI) in Korea

2020 After CI's united front & propaganda nature was exposed, HANBAN was rebranded as

Center for Language Education & Co-operation (CLEC)

Confucius Institute established by David Johnston in 2006 & HANBAN had the final say

Saint Mary University

Seneca College
in Toronto

Carleton University, Saint Mary University & Seneca College refused to show their CI contracts to media when asked

DJ was president of U of W from 1999 - 2010 & president emeritus since 2010
